We are pleased to announce the partnership between Hong Kong Kart Club (HKKC) and The Grand Prix Kart Scholarship (GPKS) Series. GPKS will provide a special discount offer for the first 5 HKKC members to sign up for the series. In addition, HKKC will sponsor the travel cost of their members competing at the GPKS races.

#### **GPKS Overview**

GPKS is the only kart scholarship program and Arrive & Drive one-make junior karting series in the Greater China region. GPKS provides drivers a single brand chassis (CRG) + engine package (IAME), with a centralized team to handle all the technical services of the karts.

The race entry fees include all kart equipment, tyres, fuel, storage, awning space, transport of the kart and event hospitality for the season. In an unprecedented move, high level coaching, education, and scholarships will also be provided to help drivers develop in the right direction towards becoming a professional race driver.

With equal spec of racing equipment, GPKS offers a platform that encourage close and fair competition while controlling the cost of racing. A particular focus will also be towards media and industry exposure for our drivers.

#### **Grand Prize**

The GPKS champion driver in the junior class will be awarded a free factory CRG drive at the 2017 IAME X30 Grand Final in Le Mans, France.

The GPKS champion driver in the cadet class will be awarded a free full season drive at the 2018 GPKS series.

The kart & engine, entry fees, race cost and technical service cost will be sponsored by GPKS. Drivers

to be responsible for crash damage, travel expenses and driver gear.

- Drivers must be between the ages of 7-11 for cadet class (reaching their 7<sup>th</sup> birthday during the calendar year and under 12 years of age on the date when license is issued)
- For junior class age between 12-15 (reaching their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday during the calendar year) and under 15 years of age on the date when license is issued)
- Valid FASC, CIK or Greater China ASN kart racing license
